Rule 114.13(g) states that in order to remain on the statewide roster, neutrals must complete continuing education hours related to ADR issues and skillsets every three years. Continuing education requirements for individuals placed on the roster go into effect the year of placement. Neutrals providing facilitative (mediation) services are required to take 18.0 hours per three-year reporting period, all other neutrals are required to take 9.0 hours per three-year reporting period. Neutrals providing both facilitative and adjudicative (arbitration) services are required to complete only 18.0 hours per three-year reporting period. If this form is not received by Aug. 30th, the form may still be accepted by October 30th, along with a \$35.00 late fee. After Oct. 30th, you will need to reapply to get back on the roster. Forms received after August 30th without the \$35.00 late fee will not be accepted.
